

Introduction

As the BI Developer you will be part of the BI & Data Team that aims to get as much value as possible out of our data within this role you will be instrumental in unlocking that value.

You'll become part of a skilled, engaged, and diverse team, supporting our co-op in its vision to be the East of England's most valued organisation.

Principle Accountabilities

- Work with business stakeholders to capture, clarify and refine their analysis and reporting requirements.
- Work with source systems specialists to understand the data available in each source system and identify the subsets of that data that will be needed to support those analysis and reporting requirements.
- Work with other members of the BI Development Team to design, build, test and deploy the reporting portal, semantic layers and pre-built reports needed to meet business users regular reporting requirements.
- Development of online interactive reports and dashboards that can be accessed from users' desktops and also from their mobile devices.
- Production and development of reports with graphical (charting), geographical (mapping) and tabular component plus the use of advanced data visualisation reports and the automated execution and distribution of reports, where appropriate.
- Design, build, test and deploy the semantic layers needed to support specific ad-hoc or self-service analysis and reporting requirements.
- Testing all new MI reports, ensuring they operate as intended, deliver accurate results, and provide acceptable performance.

This job description sets out the major tasks associated with the stated purpose of this post. Minor tasks normally considered an integral function of this post will be undertaken and not excluded simply because they are not itemised.
